Joyous Pre-Primary: Playgroup, LKG and UKG

Scholars' Home, as the name suggests serves as a 'Home away from home' for the little ones who are going through their formative years of life. The play-way method of 'Learning by Doing' is adopted at the pre-primary level. The children are given an ideal learning atmosphere where they are allowed to learn at their own pace. A great care is taken to set up an environment for the tender minds where learning comes to them naturally. Regular activities and workshops are organised for them where they are given free hand to create and experiment with new ideas under the vigilant eye and supervision of their teachers. Excursions, picnics and field trips help enhance students' understanding of their surroundings.



The emphasis is on developing in students, self- confidence and the ability to effectively communicate in English by encouraging children to create their own ideas and express themselves freely. Teachers make good use of teaching aids like Flash Cards, Picture Charts, Blocks, Puzzles, Finger and Hand Puppets, Worksheets, Beads etc. to make learning process easier, playful and interesting. Stimulating Secondary and Senior Secondary Years - Classes IX to XII

The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE-10 year) is a two-year course after eight years of schooling and comprises of classes IX and X. Also, the Indian School Certificate Course (ISC-12 year) is a two-year course after ten years of schooling and comprises of classes XI and XII. It has a wide and balanced curriculum in the local and global contexts as per the guidelines of the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi. Students appear for the ICSE and ISC Examinations conducted by the CISCE at the end of class X & XII respectively.

To prepare the students for the competitive examinations in future, the school encourages them to participate in the National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) and KVPY exam and provides guidance & necessary information to the students to be able to pursue a career of their choice after Class XII. We encourage the students to participate in MUNs, debates, quizzes and in National and International level Olympiads right from the primary.

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

We follow the method of continuous and comprehensive evaluation wherein the students' progress is assessed through class performance, informal and formal assessments.

The Examination schedule for the session is as given below:

Playgroup to Upper K.G. - Continuous and comprehensive evaluation

Classes I to IX - Term 1 (Two rounds of Assessment Tests), Half-yearly Examination, Term 2 (Two rounds of Assessment Tests), Final Examination

Class XI - Term 1 (One round of Assessment Tests), Half-yearly Examination, Term 2 (Two rounds of Assessment Tests), Final Examination

Classes X & XII - Two Comparative Examinations and two Pre-Boards

Promotion is granted on the basis of the student's overall performance throughout the academic year and securing a minimum of 40% marks in each subject in the Cumulative Assessment Tests

A student absent in any examination for any reason will not be re-examined. Preponement or postponement of written examination will not be entertained for any individual student. All cases of doubt regarding promotion are left entirely to the discretion of the Principal. Parents must not come for reconsideration once the decision has been made. A student who fails twice in the same class will have to be withdrawn from the school.

SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

Restricted Strength

Class strength of not more than 25 students helps in more personalised attention, increased participation, and higher quality interaction between the teacher and students with minimum disruptions. Equal emphasis is given to individual, small group and whole-group activities, to improve children's ability to work across all levels.

Smart Classes with Interactive whiteboards, Projectors and LED panels

Our technology-enhanced smart classrooms with interactive whiteboards make learning easier and interesting encouraging deep critical thinking with pictorial representations of the text with the help of maps, graphs, flowcharts and animated videos to further optimise children's learning experience as learning becomes fun through visualisation. It helps in delivering even the complex concepts in a manner that it enables the students to grasp and understand effortlessly.

Code of Conduct

- It is imperative for all the students to attend the Morning assembly.
- At the first warning bell before assembly, the students and teachers are expected to proceed briskly for the assembly.
- Students should keep to their left while using the corridors or staircases.
- The students must maintain complete silence and move in an orderly manner while going for P.T., Library etc. Likewise, silence must be observed during the change of periods.

- English is the medium of instruction and students must speak only in English in the school premises to acquire a good command over the language.
- Damage to school property will have to be compensated by the concerned student.
- Students must take care of the school property and must not scratch or spoil the desk and chairs, write on the walls or bring damage to any other school property.

ADMISSIONS

- Prospectus and Registration Form can be obtained from the school office by paying the registration fee. Duly filled registration form needs to be deposited in the school office within the stipulated time. The registration fee shall be non-refundable.
- Alternately, parents may click on the admission link on the school's website to access the Registration Form and submit it online by paying the registration fees.
- The admissions are mainly for the Pre-Primary classes. Admissions to other classes will be considered subject to the availability of seats.
- The minimum age requirement of the child for admission to class Playgroup is two and a half years and above.

Evaluation

Classes I to IX & XI: Informal interaction with parents and child, written evaluation

Documents Required

- If due to some reason the transfer certificate is not submitted at the time of admission, then it should be submitted within 10 days of admission, otherwise the admission is liable to be cancelled.
